
Why Use a Green Screen?


- Getting young students (or older students!) to engage with remote learning can be challenging
- Using a green screen can help capture young students' attention and keep them more engaged in remote learning sessions
- Green screen activities can be used to mimic the "hands-on" activities we would do in the classroom
- It's fun and adds a little bit of magic to a remote learning session!

How Can I Use a Green Screen?


- You can interact with the green screen using props
- You can make things "appear" and "disappear" on the green screen
- You can project pictures onto the green screen and interact with the pictures

















What Do I Need to Get Started?


- A green screen
 - You can use green felt,
 green butcher paper, a
 green plastic tablecloth
- A computer
- Zoom






To use a green screen in Zoom:

- 1. Open Zoom
- 2. Click on the arrow next to the camera
- 3. Click "Choose virtual background"
- 4. Click "Add image"
- 5. Upload a photo from your computer






Using Google Meet

- Some districts do not allow teachers to use Zoom
- Using a green screen through Google Meet is a bit more complicated, but it is possible!







Step 1: Open Zoom and turn off your camera




Step 2: Open Google Meet and turn off your camera




Step 3: Choose "present now" and "a window"



Step 4: Choose "Zoom meeting" and "Share"




Step 5: Now you're sharing your virtual background!




To toggle between virtual background pictures:

Select "Choose virtual background" in Zoom




To toggle between virtual background pictures:

- You can toggle between pictures here.
- BUT your students will see this whole screen



To toggle between virtual background pictures:

- Move your
 "Zoom
 Meeting"
 screen down
 to the bottom
 of your
 computer
 screen.
- Now, you can see all 3 tabs, but your students only see the Zoom Meeting
