Rolling back to Windows 10

We cannot stress enough that you only have 10 days after installing Windows 11 to downgrade back to Windows 10. After that, you must perform a [full reinstallation of Windows 10](#).

1. Click the **Windows** icon, then click the **Settings (gear)** icon.
 - Alternatively, use the **Windows+I** hotkey to open the Settings menu.
2. Scroll down, click **Recovery**, then click **Go back**.
 1. If the box is grayed out, this means you are past the 10-day grace period, and you will need to reinstall Windows 10 manually.
3. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the downgrade procedure.
 - When asked if you want to check for updates, click **No, thanks**.
